£100 could give visually impaired adults the chance to take part in a group social activity in their local area, helping them to feel less isolated and more involved in their community.	£500 could enable us to deliver fifteen specialist music therapy sessions for blind or partially sighted children with a range of complex needs.
£750 could support an older person with sight loss and mobility problems living in one of our residential homes through the provision of specialist equipment.	£1,500 could pay for a child to go on an outward bound residential holiday, giving them a new experience that, without specialist support, might not be possible.
£5,000 could cover the cost of a weekend residential trip to Lincolnshire for 6 families (up to 28 individuals), supported by specialist staff.
