We are changing how we support people in the current situation. For example, we have a telephone support line, where our community services team have been working through our database to call all our members during this difficult time to offer our help. We also have our volunteers who are making calls through our distant companion line to people who are isolated.

Our partners at Leicester Ageing Together and WorkLiveLeicestershire continue providing remote 1:1 support as well as contacting people with fun activities such as a sunflower seed challenge for some light relief in this time of uncertainty.

In 2019/20 we achieved Good or Outstanding ratings at all of our residential homes – a milestone which we are all immensely proud of, this speaks volumes about the quality of care in our homes and throughout the charity.

We also made progress, appointing Architects, and starting design work for our new home in Leicester Forest East.

In addition, we launched our digital hub, an online network where you can connect with other people who have sight loss. It is also an area for people who support somebody living with sight loss, care for them or are a family member who needs support.
